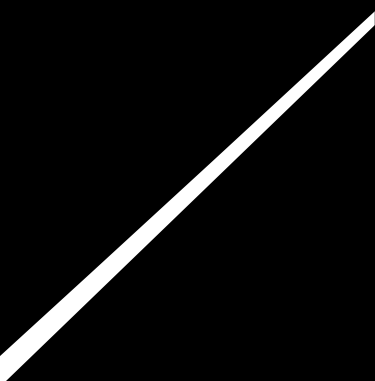

## Special Provision

Students can access special provisions provided they meet eligibility criteria on one or more of the following grounds:

- Hearing impairment
- Vision impairment
- Learning disability
- Medical condition
- Misadventure
- Personal circumstances
- Physical disability
- Psychological disorder
- Compassionate grounds

Decisions to implement special provisions are based on evidence. Examples of special provisions which can be implemented include:

- Flexibility with deadlines as negotiated
- Additional time in tests/exams (up to 10 mins/ hour)
- Adjusted assessment conditions (reduced word count, oral responses instead of a written response)
- Further support (MCE) / 100%
